

TCCF GRANT APPLICATION INFORMATION

TCCF emphasizes projects that:

- Are innovative and present opportunities to leverage other local funds raised and yield substantial local benefits for the community resources invested. Also, those projects that facilitate cooperation and collaboration between organizations, and have the potential to continue after the grant period are generally favorably reviewed.

TCCF's Granting is guided by general policies:

- Other than grants made to individuals through designated scholarship funds, grants are made to 501 (c) (3) organizations or other tax-exempt organizations and programs benefiting the citizens and communities of Tuscola County.
- Grants are made for a wide variety of charitable, community, scientific, literary, educational and cultural programs and purposes.
- Grants are not available for sectarian religious programs.
- Generally, grants are not made for operating budgets, previously incurred debt, endowment campaigns or fundraising activities.
- Projects already begun, or have been completed, are not eligible for funding.

Funds Available (see spring/fall cycle media announcement for specific funds granting in the cycle)

- **Anne Laethem** – preservation of historic buildings in Tuscola County
- **Claude D. & Etta H. Andrews** – support activities benefitting the children of Tuscola County
- **Healthy Youth/Healthy Seniors** – health-orientated programs serving youth under the age of 18 and seniors over the age of 65 in Tuscola County
- **William A. & Ruth Janks** – unrestricted programs and projects in Tuscola County with preference given to activities benefiting the residents of the Caro area.
- **Greater Millington Area Fund** – support projects benefitting the greater Millington area
- **Don List Fund for Special Needs Children** – support for special needs children, including but not limited to, those children with social, emotional, mental, or physical needs.
- **List Family Fund** – support for programs in Tuscola County in the areas of human services, the environment and the arts; preference given to Caro area. Will consider start-up costs for new programs or organizations.
- **Kiwanis Club of Caro Fund** – support children's programs and activities in Tuscola County, with preference to Caro area projects
- **Thumb Area Center for the Arts** – promoting appreciation of the arts, including but not limited to the visual, performing, and literary arts within Tuscola County.
- **Ortner Charitable Foundation** – unrestricted programs/projects that support communities in Tuscola County and the city of Frankenmuth
- **Homelessness Prevention Fund** – support programs addressing homelessness in Tuscola County
- **Don Petro Fund** – programs that support basic human needs and assistance with health issues, community infrastructure needs, sports equipment for youth and promotion of healthy lifestyle and volunteerism.
- **Neal Sisters Fund** – unrestricted, with preference to projects addressing education, horticulture, food insecurity, community development, and improvement benefitting residents of Tuscola County
- **Rick Bray & Joseph D. Klobucher Fund** -support for programs in Tuscola County in the areas of human services, the environment and the arts; charitable activities within the Caro area. Will consider start-up costs for new programs or organizations.

A. NARRATIVE

1. Organization Summary

- Briefly explain why your organization is requesting this grant, what outcomes you hope to achieve, and how you will spend the funds if the grant is made.

2. Purpose of Grant

- Statement of needs/problems to be addressed; description of target population and how they will benefit.
- Description of project goals, objectives, and statements as to whether this is a new or ongoing part of the sponsoring organization.
- Timetable for implementation (start and end dates).
- List of any partners in the project and their roles.
- What is your plan for long-term sustainability?

3. Evaluation

- Plans for evaluation, including how success will be defined and measured.

4. Budget Narrative

- Use the **Grant Budget Format** provided.
- List of amounts requested from other foundations, corporations and funding sources to which this proposal has been submitted.
- Estimates for purchase of equipment/services may be attached as support.

5. Organization Information

- Brief summary of the organization's history.
- Statement of the organization's mission and goals.
- Description of current programs, activities, and impact.
- Authorized signatures for schools include Superintendent or Principal, for non-profits include CEO or Exe. Director

B. ATTACHMENTS

1. A copy of the current IRS determination letter indicating 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status.
2. List of Board of Directors.

C. FORMAT

1. Provide one legible (preferably typed) original copy, printed single-sided (DO NOT STAPLE).
2. All grant applications become property of the Tuscola County Community Foundation once received.
3. Incomplete applications will not be considered (i.e. unsigned, missing narrative, budget not included, etc.)
4. If you are applying to more than one Fund, you must submit an original copy for each Fund you are applying to.
